

## HAND-IN FOR PANEL OF THREE

Here is how I produce a straightforward Panel Of Three DPI. Of course, there are other arrangements of three images on a shared background, but the principles are the same. Remember: No overlapping!

Using your editing software of choice (eg. Photoshop)



Start with centre image. Original size is OK.



Decide on a suitable border for top and bottom and then go to “CANVAS” and add that all around.



Work out width of canvas (image x 3) + (border x 4)



Add left image



Add right image.



You are not obliged to include borders, but do not overlap images.

Finally, “Flatten” your result and save as a Jpeg in sRGB colour space and then reduce size to Maximum 1200px high and maximum 1600px wide or allow PhotoEntry to reduce the size for you.

Enter the image in the usual way into PhotoEntry. If submitting a Print Panel make a note of the PSN and note this on the print label remembering to include “Left”, “Centre” and “Right” (or L,C,R) so that the prints match with the PhotoEntry DPI.

Hope this helps.
